33rd Ahmadiyya Annual Convention Examines Religious, Contemporary, and Moral Issues

MISSISSAUGA: Over fifteen thousand participants attended the second day of the 33rd Annual Conference of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community, a three-day event being held at the International Centre, Mississauga (Derry and Airport Roads). The Ahmadiyya Muslim Community, which is known worldwide for its motto, "Love for All, Hatred for None", has been hosting such conferences for over a century throughout the world.

During the conference's second day, scholars discussed, amongst other topics, the moral and spiritual excellences of the Founder of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community and the companions of the Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him), the correct interpretation of the finality of his prophethood according to the most revered scholarship of Islamic history, as well as the correct understanding of the Shariah concept of justice and criminal punishment.
